But no, it was Santa The Santa of Hams, On a mission this Christmas To clean up the bands.


He circled the tower,

Most of you should be familiar with the KYHAM web site available at www.kyham.net. The site was started over 15 years ago as an forum hosted on a local dial-up bulletin board system for hams in Lexington, KY.

In the mid 90's, it became possible for home Internet users to put up a web page on their personal account. The KYHAM web site was born as a list of coordinators around the state with their contact information so that any ham in Kentucky could find them.

events around the area such as walks, runs and bike rides, parades and other gatherings. We use these events as a training opportunity and a way to educate the public about amateur radio.

Every licensed amateur, regardless of membership in ARRL or any other local or national organization is eligible for membership in ARES. The only requirements are possession of an amateur radio license, some basic training, and a sincere desire to serve.
